

Messiah Beanbag Toss

Print one copy for your use in class.

GAME DIRECTIONS

- Make a 2' or larger square with masking tape on the floor. Divide the inside of the square into sections. An X will make 4 sections. Assign each section a number value.
- Divide the class into two or more teams depending on size. Give each team a beanbag.
- Students will toss a beanbag then get a question to answer.
- If they answer correctly, they will be awarded the number of points according to where the beanbag landed.
- If the team misses the question another team may try. If no one gets the answer, give the answer and repeat the question later in the game.
- Repeat questions, or add others according to your class and your lesson.

MESSIAH BEANBAG TOSS REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. When did God first tell about a Savior in the Bible? *Hint: It is the very first book of the Bible. Genesis.*
2. Who spoke for God in the Old Testament? *The prophets.*
3. Name one of the prophets God spoke through? *Allow several students to name an Old Testament prophet. Amos, Hosea, Nahum, Micah, Isaiah, Jeremiah, etc.*
4. Who is God speaking through now? *Jesus.*
5. Where do we read what God spoke through the prophets—which part of the Bible? *The Old Testament.*
6. And where do we read Jesus's words from God? *The New Testament.*
7. What makes Jesus different from the prophets of old? Who is He? *He is God.*
8. How did some people react when they knew Jesus, the Savior, was born? *They rejoiced!*
9. Who in our lesson rejoiced when he saw Jesus? *Simeon.*
10. Where was Simeon when he saw the Savior? *In the Temple.*
11. True or false: The Old Testament talks about Jesus. *True.*
12. True or false? The New Testament talks about Jesus. *True.*
13. What did Simeon do when he saw the baby Jesus? *Held Him in his arms and blessed God.*
14. God will always keep His promises. Which attribute is that? *Faithful.*
15. What is the memory verse we are going to learn? *John 1:14.*
16. Who is this memory verse talking about? Who is the Word? *Jesus.*
